

Examples of checklists for community-based frontline health workers in South Sudan Here are two of nine checklists from the Maternal, Newborn, and Child Survival (MNCS) Initiative, which was developed and implemented countrywide by Massachusetts General Hospital and the Ministry of Health. These two checklists illustrate the basic steps in newborn care (drying, assessing, clearing airway, tying and cutting the cord, and ventilating with bag-mask-device) and dangers signs in young children (fast indrawing breathing, convulsions, unconsciousness, high temperature and refusal to eat).
